





















Design for maintenance, maintain the design.

Perennial Staying Power

- Use large perennials in place of shrubs
- Mix with shrubs
- Use large masses
- Embrace the seasons
- Use proven cultivars
- Promotes ecological diversity often in very sterile environments













Annual Fluff

- Use masses or small groups depending on situation
- Use a limited colour palette and three to fives types
- Repeat choices in beds/planters
- Respect the original design of the landscape
- Use loose combinations and intermix
